Course Description

This course builds on your knowledge of HTML. Students should already know how to operate a computer, use a Web browser and understand the fundamentals of scripting or programming.

Class Description

The class consists of a lecture, demonstrations, and in-class exercises. *Since this is a hands-on course, attendance is strongly encouraged.* We meet once a week for four weeks. Each class lasts three hours.
